CREDIT TRANSFER

The US Accreditation systems ensure that quality of education is high, consistent and reliable for students and institutions within the United States.

Students on the ONCAMPUS Boston program will be awarded Wheelock College credits. The accrediting body of Wheelock College is the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC), which accredits more than 2000 public and private schools, including prestigious names such as Dartmouth College, Harvard University, Boston College, Yale University and Brown University.

The credits earned by ONCAMPUS Boston students will be used to assist students to transfer to their chosen Year 2/ Sophomore Year at Wheelock College or other suitable institutions. Full support and guidance will be offered by our expert team to assist with the application process.









PROGRAM CONTENT

The University Transfer Program provides students with an ideal first year liberal arts foundation program, designed to give ONCAMPUS Boston students a solid academic grounding combined with an intensive language preparation program.

WHAT YOU WILL STUDY

The American education system usually divides the school year into two semesters: fall (September – December) and spring (January – May).

All ONCAMPUS students will study English and their choice of available General Education classes. Students will then chose pathway-specific courses based on their major or intended course of study and study the same pathway for both semesters.

STEP THREE

To accept your place on the course you will need to send the deposit payment as indicated in your offer letter.

In your offer letter, you may be requested to send some additional documentation to prove you meet the conditions mentioned.

STEP FIVE

You will then need to obtain your student visa from the US Consulate or Embassy in your home country before traveling to the USA.

STEP SIX

You will need to pay at least the first semester's tuition fees before you begin your programme of study at ONCAMPUS Boston.

STEP TWO

Our Central Admissions team will review your application.

- If you have provided documentation to show you have the academic qualifications and meet all the academic entry requirements, you will be sent a conditional offer letter.
- If we have any queries about your application, our Central Admissions team will contact you for further information.

STEP FOUR




